2017 St. Louis River Canoe Tour and Picnic Day of Event Information

How to Get There:

Oliver Boat Landing: From Duluth take HWY 23 to Gary/New Duluth, go East on HWY 39 across Oliver Bridge (turns in to HWY 105). Go South on S. Chicago Ave (Cty W) and West on E Detroit St. until you reach the landing. Volunteers will be helping park.

Proceed to the boat landing to drop off canoe /kayak and/or passengers and gear. Parking may be limited at the boat landing.

What to Bring:

The essentials:

- Jacket, hat, sunscreen
- Life jacket - if you don't have one - one will be provided.
- Bottle of water, or container for water
- Beverage of choice for picnic (non-alcoholic)
- Bag chair or folding lawn chair (please leave in your vehicle until we get back to the landing for the picnic).

The optionals:

- Seat cushion.
- Camera, binoculars for bird watching
- Rain gear

What to Expect:

If you have reserved a canoe, find the volunteers who are making canoe assignments. Let them know how many adults and children are in your group, and who has any canoe experience.

There is LIMITED seats on a pontoon if you cannot paddle. RSVP for first come, first serve.

The tour is guided and everyone will leave the boat landing together as a group. The tour will explore areas of interest in this part of the river. We will also have a plant expert in the group to help us identify native and non-native plants, as well as some medicinal plants. Motorboat assistance will be available to anyone who may need it.

The picnic will be held at Oliver Boat Landing after the canoe tour. It will include hot dogs, brats, hamburgers, salads, baked beans, and bars, etc. (Veggie dogs will be provided.) Bring along your own beverage. Bring your own chair. Tables will not be provided.

This event will be held rain or shine! So bring appropriate gear. However, if conditions are not safe to be on the river, the canoe tour portion may be shortened or cancelled.
